



Green Corner

This Quarter's Topic: Glass Tile

SUSTAINABILITY

All glass tile is made primarily from silica sand, an abundant natural resource with many colors also containing recycled content that include pre-consumer*, post-industrial**, and/or post-consumer*** recycled bottle glass from curbside recycling programs.

*Pre-consumer materials are generated during our manufacturing process and may consist of scrap and trimmings that were never used in the consumer market.

**Post-Industrial: Material from manufacturing processes where virgin resources would otherwise go to waste. This material is collected and used in a product other than that for which it was originally used.

***Post-consumer material is an end product that has completed its life cycle as a consumer item and would otherwise have been disposed of as a solid waste. Post-consumer material can be recycled bottle glass from curbside recycling programs.

DURABILITY AS PART OF SUSTAINABILITY

Glass tile is a very strong building material that is impervious to water and freeze/thaw resistant. This long-lasting durability further adds to its sustainability.

*For example, breaking strength on 4" x 4" Field Tile is approximately 900 pounds per square inch of force.
