The raw material components of Northwest products are entirely synthetic; therefore there is the potential for those materials to consist of recycled content. From the primary and secondary backings, to the yarns used in tufting, there are options available to utilize highly sustainable raw materials. One such option is the 100% recycled solution dyed nylon ECONYL® from Aquafil. Aquafil, a close industry partner with Northwest, is a leader in sustainability, pushing for entirely closed-loop systems in their industrial processes. Most impressively, they accomplish these sustainability goals with no loss to the excellent performance qualities of their product.
